

Whatever website you want to visit will be unblocked, with the assistance of the proxy. Don't worry if you are not sure about security because a private proxy offers it. It makes sure that

your connection is encrypted and safe from snoopers. What's more, you can choose whether you want to use a hidden public proxy or a hidden private proxy, depending on how much you care about privacy. Why use a proxy? If you use the Internet, you probably already know that some websites, which should be available to everybody, are being blocked, censored, or restricted, depending on where you are in the world. If you're using a public proxy to unblock websites, you can bypass this kind of censorship.
